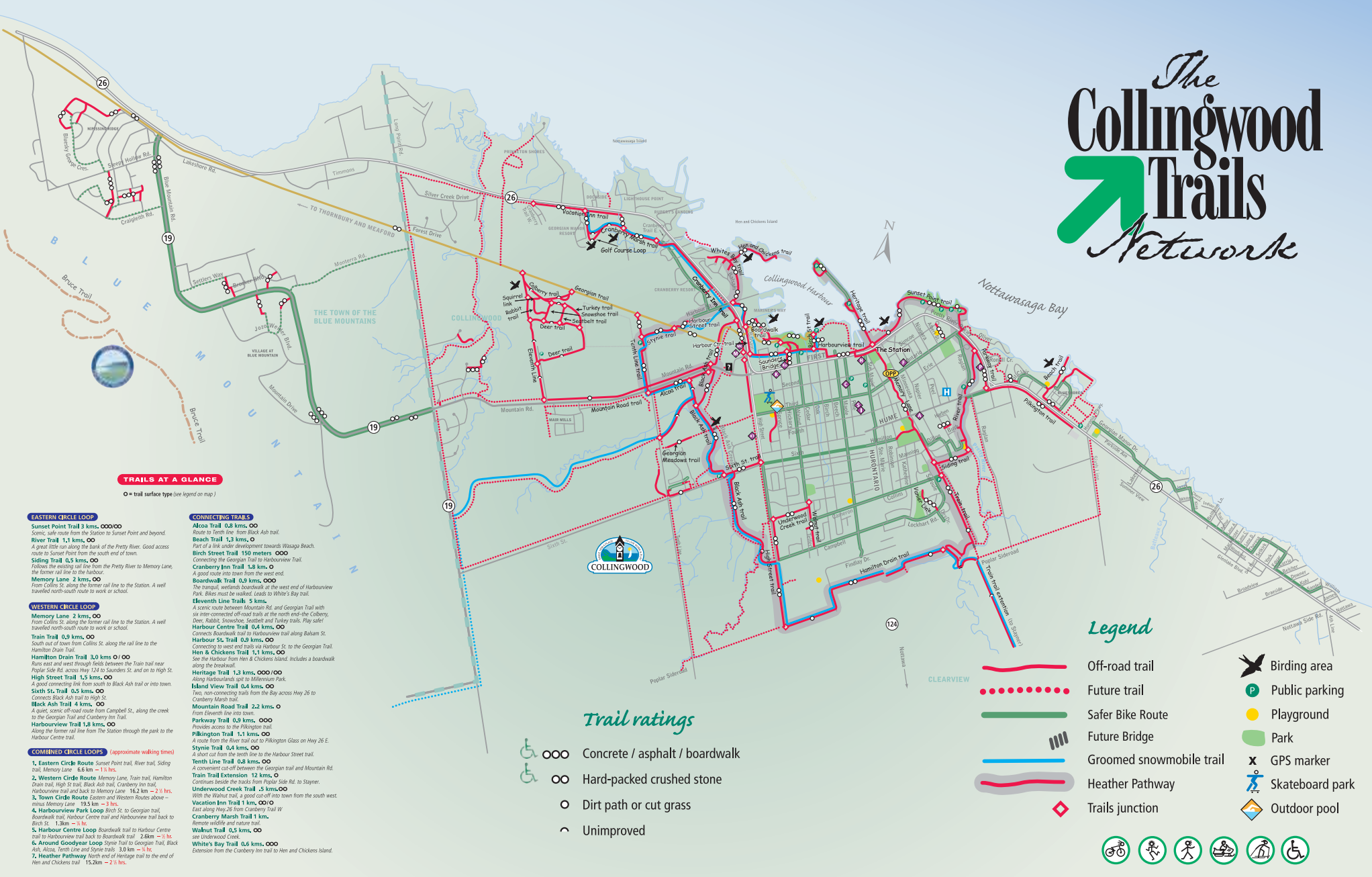


The Collingwood Trails Network



TRAILS AT A GLANCE

○ = trail surface type (see legend on map)

EASTERN CIRCLE LOOP

Sunset Point Trail 3 kms, ○○○○
Scenic, safe route from the Station to Sunset Point and beyond.
River Trail 1.1 kms, ○○
A great little run along the banks of the Pretty River. Good access route to Sunset Point from the south end of town.
Siding Trail 0.5 kms, ○○
Follows the existing rail line from the Pretty River to Memory Lane, the former rail line to the harbour.
Memory Lane 2 kms, ○○
From Collins St. along the former rail line to the Station. A well travelled north-south route to work or school.

WESTERN CIRCLE LOOP

Memory Lane 2 kms, ○○
From Collins St. along the former rail line to the Station. A well travelled north-south route to work or school.
Train Trail 0.9 kms, ○○
South out of town from Collins St. along the rail line to the Hamilton Drain Trail.
Hamilton Drain Trail 3.0 kms ○○○
Run east and west through fields between the Train trail near Poplar Side Rd. across Hwy 124 to Saunders St. and on to High St.
High Street Trail 1.5 kms, ○○
A good connecting link from south to Black Ash trail or into town.
Sixth St. Trail 0.5 kms, ○○
Connects Black Ash trail to High St.
Black Ash Trail 4 kms, ○○
A quiet, scenic off-road route from Campbell St., along the creek to the Georgian Trail and Cranberry Inn Trail.
Harbourview Trail 1.8 kms, ○○
Along the former rail line from the Station through the park to the Harbour Centre trail.

COMBINED CIRCLE LOOPS (approximate walking times)

- 1. Eastern Circle Route** Sunset Point trail, River trail, Siding trail, Memory Lane. 6.8 km — 1.5 hrs.
- 2. Western Circle Route** Memory Lane, Train trail, Hamilton Drain trail, High St trail, Black Ash trail, Cranberry Inn trail, Harbourview trail and back to Memory Lane. 16.2 km — 2.5 hrs.
- 3. Town Circle Route** Eastern and Western Routes above — minus Memory Lane. 19.5 km — 3 hrs.
- 4. Harbourview Park Loop** Birch St. to Georgian trail, Boardwalk trail, Harbour Centre trail and Harbourview trail back to Birch St. 1.7 km — 1 hr.
- 5. Harbour Centre Loop** Boardwalk trail to Harbour Centre trail to Harbourview trail back to Boardwalk trail. 2.8 km — 1 hr.
- 6. Around Goodbye Loop** Siding Trail to Georgian Trail, Black Ash, Alcoa, Tenth Line and Sycamore trails. 3.0 km — 1 hr.
- 7. Heather Pathway** North end of Heritage trail to the end of Hen and Chickens trail. 15.2 km — 2.5 hrs.

CONNECTING TRAILS

Alcoa Trail 0.8 kms, ○○
Route to North Ave. from Black Ash trail.
Beach Trail 1.3 kms, ○
Part of a link under development towards Wasaga Beach.
Birch Street Trail 150 metres ○○○
Connecting the Georgian Trail to Harbourview Trail.
Cranberry Inn Trail 1.8 kms, ○
A good route into town from the west end.
Boardwalk Trail 0.9 kms, ○○○○
The tranquil, well-used boardwalk at the west end of Harbourview Park. Bikes must be walked. Leads to White's Bay trail.

Eleventh Line Trails 5 kms.
A scenic route between Kousarou Rd. and Georgian Trail with six inter-connected off-road trails at the north end—the Colburn, Deer Rabbit, Snowshoe, Seaside and Turkey trails. Play safe!
Harbour Centre Trail 0.4 kms, ○○
Connects Boardwalk trail to Harbourview trail along Balsam St.
Harbour St. Trail 0.9 kms, ○○
Connects to west end trails via Harbour St. to the Georgian Trail.
Hen & Chickens Trail 1.1 kms, ○○○
See the Harbour from Hen & Chickens Island. Includes a boardwalk along the breakwall.
Heritage Trail 1.3 kms, ○○○/○○○
Along Harbourlands spots to Millennium Park.

Island View Trail 0.9 kms, ○○
Ferry, non-connecting trails from the Bay across Hwy 26 to Cranberry Marsh trail.
Mountain Road Trail 2.2 kms, ○○
From Eleventh line into town.
Parkway Trail 0.9 kms, ○○○○
Provides access to the Pilkington trail.
Pilkington Trail 1.1 kms, ○○
A route from the River trail out to Pilkington Glass on Hwy 26 E.
Sycamore Trail 0.4 kms, ○○
A short cut from the tenth line to the Harbour Street trail.

Tenth Line Trail 0.8 kms, ○○
A convenient cut-off between the Georgian trail and Mountain Rd.
Train Trail Extension 12 kms, ○
Continues inside the tracks from Poplar Side Rd. to Stager.
Underwood Creek Trail .5 kms, ○○○
With the Walnut trail, a good cut-off into town from the south-west.
Vacation Inn Trail 1 km, ○○○○
East along Hwy 26 from Cranberry Trail W.
Cranberry Marsh Trail 1 km, ○○○○
Remote wildlife and nature trail.
Walnut Trail 0.5 kms, ○○
See Underwood Creek.
White's Bay Trail 0.6 kms, ○○○○
Extension from the Cranberry Inn trail to Hen and Chickens Island.
