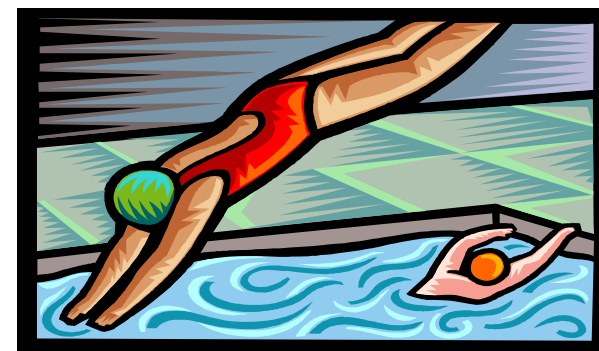

Swim Patrol **\$70.00**

Pre-requisites: able to swim 100m
Recommended for ages 9 to 12 years. Consist or 3 levels: Rookie, Ranger and Star. Each level has 3 modules: H₂O proficiency, first aid and recognition and response.

Bronze Star **\$115.00**

Recommended but not required preparatory course for Bronze Medallion. Focus on fitness, first aid and basic rescue skills

Bronze Medallion/Emergency First Aid **\$150.00**

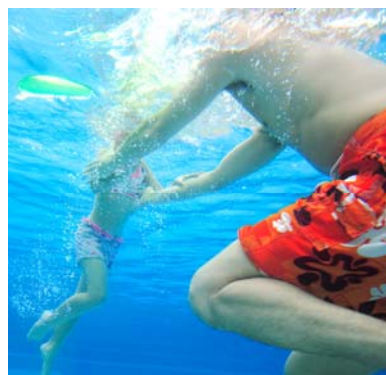
Pre-requisites: 13 years or age or completed Bronze Star. Focus on fitness, rescue skills, first aid and lifesaving principles

Bronze Cross **\$150.00**

Pre-requisites: Bronze Medallion and Emergency First Aid. Focus on advance training and introduction to safe supervision in aquatic facilities.

Standard First Aid/CPR "C" **\$125.00**

Pre-requisites: Minimum of 12 years or age. Focus on life support skills, resuscitation and first aid.
